

Camp Honor Bright (Ages 6-12)

A traditional outdoor day camp, Camp Honor Bright is designed to provide children with the excitement and thrill of camping. Activities combine both large and small group participation where children are encouraged to try new activities. These new settings and activities develop self-confidence, acceptance of responsibility, and improved social skills.

- Limited to 100 participants per week (50 in Honor Bright 1, 50 in Honor Bright 2).
- Honor Bright 1 is for ages 6 – 8. Honor Bright 2 is for ages 9 – 11.
- Themes will run for two consecutive weeks. There will typically be two field trips for each theme. Honor Bright 1 will go on one of the field trips during the first week of a theme, while Honor Bright 2 will go on the other selected field trip for the theme.

THEMES

JUNE 7-11 and JUNE 14-18: Surfing into Summer

We'll hit the waves and surf into summer the way only Camp Honor Bright can! As campers learn their way around Honor Bright, we'll introduce them to all of this outdoor camp's traditions, as well as add some new ones! During the first week of camp, Honor Bright 1 will enjoy a Luau complete with a cookout and fun beach themed games. Meanwhile, Honor Bright 2 will head to Atlantis Water Park to hit the waves and ride the slides! During the second week of camp, Honor Bright 1 will have some fun in the sun at Atlantis, while Honor Bright 2 kicks off the year with a Luau of their own.

JUNE 21-25 and JUNE 28-JULY 2: Traditional Camp and Wildlife Weeks

These two weeks are all about the great outdoors and what better place to start than at Camp Honor Bright! Campers will get a chance to participate in traditional outdoor camp activities, while getting to know more about the awesome outdoor world around them. During the first week of this theme, Honor Bright 1 will head to the Louisville Zoo to learn about all creatures that run, slither, creep and crawl, while Honor Bright 2 will have fun making smores and camping out at Honor Bright (KIDS ONLY, Date TBA). The next week, Honor Bright 1 will spend time around the camp fire and camping out (KIDS ONLY, Date TBA) while Honor Bright 2 takes a walk on the wild side at the Louisville Zoo.

JULY 5-9: Olympic Week

Join in on the Olympic Spirit, as Camp Honor Bright defends its Olympic title from last year! This friendly competition between all of the YMCA camps gives every camper a chance to get in on the fun and will award the winner with the Hard 4 Core Values Award. All campers will receive a Camp Honor Bright Olympic shirt, learn to make an Olympic tie dye shirt and will have a great time enjoying some friendly competition with the other camps! JULY 12-16 and JULY 19-23: Wacky Water Weeks

It doesn't get wackier or wetter than this! Campers should make sure to pack a bathing suit and a towel, as we have fun with crazy water games, have a monster water slide and extreme water gun and water balloon fights. JULY 26-30 and AUGUST 2-6: Xtreme Outdoor Sports and Games

Get ready for one wild and Xtreme week of camp! Campers will get a chance to play some fast-paced, highly interactive camp games that they are familiar with, such as Capture the Flag and Ultimate Frisbee, as well as explore some new Xtreme games. Campers will also have the chance to get Xtreme with field trips to Puzzle's Fun Dome and Buffalo Trace Park. Honor Bright 1 will go to Puzzle's during the first week of this theme, while Honor Bright 2 is teeing off on the disk golf course and playing some Xtreme games at Buffalo Trace. The next week, Honor Bright 1 will have a blast at Buffalo Trace, while Honor Bright 2 is hitting the slides and other Xtreme activities at Puzzles.

AUGUST 9-13: Survivor – Out wit, out last, out play

There will be friendly Survivor competitions between the tribes challenged to motivate, kick up the energy, and increase self esteem.
